

Orbeseal

Drug:

Bismuth subnitrate in an oil base

Uses:

As an aid in the prevention of new intramammary infection during the dry period by providing a barrier in the teat canal.

Dosage:

Clean teats as thoroughly as possible with alcohol starting with the two teats farthest away, followed by the closest two teats. Infuse 1 tube per quarter at dry-off following complete milk-out with proper teat end preparation and sanitation starting with the two teats closest to you followed by the two further away. Do not massage the udder or teat following infusion. After infusion dip teats with teat dip disinfectant.

Frequency: Once

Route:

This drug is labeled for Intramammary (IMM) infusion

Duration: Dry period

Withhold:

Milk 0 days when used alone

Meat 0 days when used alone

Special Considerations:

For use in **DRY COWS ONLY**. This product contains no antibiotics.
