

# Pirsue

## Drug:

Pirlimycin hydrochloride 50mg/ tube

## Uses:

For intramammary use to treat clinical and subclinical mastitis in dairy cows caused by staphylococci species such as *Staphylococcus aureus* and streptococcus species including *Streptococcus agalactiae*, *Streptococcus dysgalactiae* and *Streptococcus uberis*

## Dosage:

Infuse 1 tube into each affected quarter following proper teat end preparation and sanitation.

Frequency: Once every 24 hours

## Route:

This drug is labeled for Intramammary (IMM) infusion

## Duration:

For extended duration therapy, once daily treatment may be repeated for up to 8 consecutive days. For extended duration therapy, only infuse quarters known to be infected with drug label pathogens. Do not concurrently infuse un-infected low SCC quarters of the same cow.

## Withhold:

Milk **Milk taken from cows during treatment + 36 hours after last treatment**

Meat **9 days after last infusion when using 2 day treatment protocol  
21 days after last infusion when using any extended duration therapy beyond 2 days and up to 8 days of drug therapy**
