Pirsue

Drug:

Pirlimycin hydrochloride 50mg/tube

Uses:

For intramammary use to treat clinical and subclinical mastitis in dairy cows caused by staphylococci species such as Staphylococcus aureus and streptococcus species including Streptococcus agalactiae, Streptococcus dysgalactiae and Streptococcus uberis

Dosage:

Infuse 1 tube into each affected quarter following proper teat end preparation and sanitation.

Frequency: Once every 24 hours

Route:

This drug is labeled for Intramammary (IMM) infusion

Duration:

For extended duration therapy, once daily treatment may be repeated for up to 8 consecutive days. For extended duration therapy, only infuse quarters known to be infected with drug label pathogens. Do not concurrently infuse un-infected low SCC quarters of the same cow.

Withhold:

Milk Milk taken from cows during treatment + 36 hours after last treatment

Meat 9 days after last infusion when using 2 day treatment protocol 21 days after last infustion when using any extended duration therapy beyond 2 days and up to 8 days of drug therapy
