

## Today

Drug:

Cephapirin sodium 200mg/ tube

Uses:

For intramammary use in the treatment of mastitis in lactating cows caused by susceptible strains of *Streptococcus agalactiae* and *Staphylococcus aureus* including strains resistant to penicillin

Dosage:

Infuse 1 tube into each affected quarter following proper teat end preparation and sanitation.

Frequency: One treatment every 12 hours for 2 total treatments

Route:

This drug is labeled for Intramammary (IMM) infusion

Duration:

2 treatments 12 hours apart

Withhold:

Milk **Milk taken from cows during treatment + 96 hours after last treatment**

Meat **4 days after last treatment**
