

# Tomorrow

Drug:

Cephapirin benzathine 300mg/ tube

Uses:

For intramammary use in dairy cows during the dry period for the treatment of mastitis caused by susceptible strains of *Streptococcus agalactiae* and *Staphylococcus aureus* including strains resistant to penicillin

Dosage:

Infuse 1 tube per quarter at dry-off following complete milk-out with proper teat end preparation and sanitation.

Frequency: Once

Route:

This drug is labeled for Intramammary (IMM) infusion

Duration:

Not to be used within 30 days of calving

Withhold:

Milk 72 hours after calving

Meat 42 days after the last treatment

Special Considerations:

For use in **DRY COWS ONLY**. Not to be used within 30 days of calving.
