

## Zactran®

Drug:

Gamithromycin 150mg/mL

Uses: **NOT FOR DAIRY ANIMALS OLDER THAN 20 MONTHS, LACTATING DAIRY CATTLE or CALVES INTENDED FOR VEAL**

Bovine Respiratory Disease associated with Mannheimia haemolytica, Pasteurella multocida, Histophilus somni and Mycoplasma bovis in beef and non-lactating dairy cattle.

Dosage:

Administer 2mL/110lbs animal body weight one time.

Frequency:

Zactran therapy is given one time.

Route:

This drug is labeled for Subcutaneous (SQ) injection. No more than 10mL should be injected into any single location. For example, a 20mL dose should be injected into two separate locations, preferably in the neck to insure minimal tissue damage.

Duration:

Duration of antibiotic action is around 10 days.

Withhold:

Milk **NOT FOR DAIRY ANIMALS OLDER THAN 20 MONTHS, LACTATING DAIRY CATTLE or CALVES INTENDED FOR VEAL.**

Meat **35 Days**
