Zactran®

Drug:

Gamithromycin 150mg/mL

Uses: NOT FOR DAIRY ANIMALS OLDER THAN 20 MONTHS, LACTATING

DAIRY CATTLE or CALVES INTENDED FOR VEAL

Bovine Respiratory Disease associated with Mannheimia haemolytica, Pasteurella multocida, Histophilus somni and Mycoplasma bovis in beef and non-lactating dairy cattle.

Dosage:

Administer 2mL/110lbs animal body weight one time.

Frequency:

Zactran therapy is given one time.

Route:

This drug is labeled for Subcutaneous (SQ) injection. No more than 10mL should be injected into any single location. For example, a 20mL dose should be injected into two separate locations, preferably in the neck to insure minimal tissue damage.

Duration:

Duration of antibiotic action is around 10 days.

Withhold:

Milk NOT FOR DAIRY ANIMALS OLDER THAN 20 MONTHS,

LACTATING DAIRY CATTLE or CALVES INTENDED FOR VEAL.
